

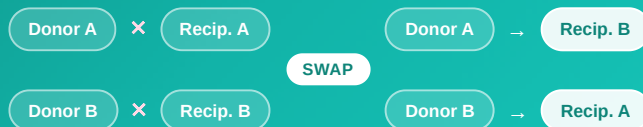

Incompatible doesn't have to mean the end.

KEPSA is South Africa's national kidney paired-donation platform — connecting transplant centres across the country to turn incompatible living-donor pairs into life-saving matches. Built with Groote Schuur Hospital, fostering collaboration between the public and private sectors to deliver sustainable healthcare development.

What if incompatibility wasn't the end?

KEPSA matches incompatible donor-recipient pairs with others in the same situation — creating compatible swap chains. By exchanging donors, both pairs secure a compatible kidney.

Most incompatible living-donor pairs hit a dead end. KEPSA removes four common barriers to transplant.
